



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
MONGOLIAN TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY
AND
SOUTH DAKOTA SCHOOL OF MINES AND TECHNOLOGY**

In consideration of the desire by Mongolian Technical University (MTU) and the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology (SDSM&T) to continue close cooperative efforts in defining and developing mutually beneficial opportunities, the following areas of collaboration will be considered:

- An exchange of a review of current research activities from each university to lead to joint research and technology development projects,
- A sharing of resumes and areas of expertise of faculty and staff who have interest in developing cooperative relationships in education and research leading to the exchange of faculty and staff in those areas of education critical to support national growth and development,
- An encouragement of the development of collaborative programs of study, including opportunities for joint field and research studies, and the completion of degree programs in areas of critical need to the national growth,
- A joint review of current activities designed to improve educational programs and courses,
- An exchange of possible areas for the sharing of programs, courses and/or special lectures through the use of video tapes and/or other telecommunication linkages,
- A sharing of available information resources including library materials and research publications.
