A. Volunteers Wellness Center

A lot parking is on the edges of campus where a lot of break ins happen so either looking into a resolution or a policy change.
- <u>Senator Lewis:</u> Do we know why the parking lot across the road is not open for overnight parking anymore?
 - President Marshall: It actually belongs to CARA, as to why I'll inquire about that.
 - <u>Director Headly:</u> The one thing you would need to keep in mind with that lot, is if they had a specific alumni event in the alumni building.
- Senator Archer: I've heard talk that the school has restricted parking despite the increase in class size. Lots of complaints about daytime parking but restricted overnight parking.
- <u>Senator Lewis:</u> Past senates have looked at parking garage but have been brushed away do you know about have far those projects have gone?
- o <u>President Marshall:</u> I don't know it has been brought up.
- Senator Headly: They are very expensive which what has probably stopped them from being implemented.
- Senator Jurrens: Last I heard it was \$30000 a spot and parking garages have about 20-year life span.

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 President Marshall: A lot of student GAF goes to bonded buildings, eventually those bonds expire, so in 7-8 years money could be available through a bond to pay for a parking garage. Senator Lannerd: What are the current plans for the practice field? President Marshall: I'm not sure about the strategic plan for there. Senator Jurrens: I don't think that will happen till a lot of other things happen because it's used regularly by the athletic teams. President Marshall: Was it proposed to move the field up to the divide? Senator Jurrens: Those plans confidential, I think.
