

# **Campus Culture Committee**

#### **Committee Charter/Purpose:**

The purpose of the Campus Culture Committee is to engage students, faculty and staff, and industry partners on items related to the strategic priority of Campus Culture. Industry partners will be selected from local businesses by the current IC members and will also rotate annually to allow for a broader sampling of partners. Co-chairs will remain on the committee indefinitely. Members may serve consecutive terms.
