## **Policy Manual**

SUBJECT: Distinguished Professor Designation

NUMBER: **Policy 4-7** (formerly Policy IV-C-03 and IV-16)

The Distinguished Professor designation provides special recognition to professors of high achievement.

- 1. The designation of distinguished professor is awarded on the basis of sustained high-level achievement in all areas of the scholarly activities of teaching, research or other creative endeavors, and service.
- 2. The designation of distinguished professor will be used to identify selected individuals holding the rank of full professor, who, in addition, have distinguished themselves by:
  - A. performance that gives evidence of a high dedication to teaching as demonstrated by recognition from colleagues and students; and
  - B. achievements that exemplify high quality research or other scholarly creative endeavors through recognition from peers of national and international status; and
  - C. accomplishments that include evidence of high-quality, sustained service to the institution, community, region, or nation.
- 3. No more than one such designation may be made annually, and there will be no requirement to make such a designation in any year.
- 4. Nominations for the designation of distinguished professor may be made by the department heads. Letters of nomination must address each of the criteria in 2.A C, and include a complete curriculum vitae for the nominee. This material shall be delivered to the Provost/Vice President for Academic Affairs by November 15<sup>th</sup> for review, comment, and forwarding to the institutional Promotion and Tenure Committee.
- 5. The institutional Promotion and Tenure Committee will provide a recommendation of appropriate action regarding the nomination for distinguished professor to the Provost and President by January 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 6. Following the institutional Promotion and Tenure Committee's recommendation, the Provost, with the agreement of the President, will select the recipient of the distinguished professor designation.
